

## ATTENTION MUSICIANS

Pulling too hard on your pickup's cable can cause excessive strain on the plug connection, resulting in static or loss of sound. Don't panic! Your new Dean Markley Acoustic Pickup comes equipped with a special Solderless Plug which you can repair very easily, on your own, without a soldering gun. Just follow these easy instructions.

1. Loosen set screw on 1/4 inch plug. Unscrew half way out, *counting number of turns*. Pull cable out.
2. Cut 2 or 3 inches off the end of the cable.
3. Push the straight, fresh-cut end of the cable as deep into the plug as you can.
4. Return the set screw (*same number of turns as in step one*) back into the plug.
5. Test the pickup. Make sure you tightened the set screw enough.

You're back in business... with a new plug !
